# About NPTI(PSTI), Bangalore



- ❖ In 1972 Government of India established Load Dispatch Training Institute (LDTI) under CEA at Bangalore for planning and managing large regional power grids. Later on this has been named as Power Systems Training Institute (PSTI) to cover other facets of power system operation also.
- ❖ In 2002 PSTI was merged with National Power Training Institute (NPTI). PSTI has emerged as one of the few of its kind in India, in imparting training in all facets of Power System Operation to fresh and serving engineers of all the State/ Regional Electricity Boards and Power Supply Undertakings in the country.
