## About the Location

### About the Venue

The venue hotel Radisson Blu Kochi is located in Kochi's city centre and within 100 meters of the Elamkulam Metro Station, making prominent businesses, transport stops, and prime shopping destinations like LuLu Mall and MC Road easily accessible.
