

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Role of National Power Training Institute (NPTI) for the training programmes in Power Sector in the Country – reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Para No. 4 of the Resolution No. 21/1/91-T&R Ministry of Power, New Delhi, dated 26th May, 1993. As per the above Resolution:

“The National Power Training Institute together with its Training Institutes will function as a National Apex Body for fulfilling the training requirements of the power sector in the country by coordinating the training programmes of the various Utilities and other technical Institutions and supplement the same with the training programmes of its own Training Institutes.”

2. NPTI is a leading integrated power training institute. NPTI being a National Apex body for training in Power Sector has trained over 3,20,000 Power Professionals in regular Programs over the last 5 decades. NPTI has also conducted 5 training programs for 9500 trainees under RDSS. NPTI is designated as assessment and certifying body for System Operators (NLDC, RLDC, SLDC) and certification agency for cyber security for power professionals of LDCs, GENCOS, Transmission & Distribution by Ministry of Power. It has also been nominated as a certifying body by National Skill Development Agency (NSDA) of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship .

3. In view of above, CEA/all CPSUs and other Utilities of power sector are requested to nominate/send their officers for training courses being conducted by National Power Training Institute, to the extent available/feasible. This, in turn, will avoid running same training programmes by the power sector Organizations/Utilities and incurring expenditure for developing similar infrastructure facilities in different places.

4. Further, NPTI being National Apex body for training programmes relating to power sector in the country need to be consulted invariably while initiating/developing any training programmes relating to manpower training/capacity building for power sector. It is also advised that NPTI may be involved in all training matters of power sector even if a particular training programme is not being conducted by NPTI, so as to facilitate them in compiling complete data/records relating to trainings conducted in power sector of the country.
